## BEHIND THE NAME

Like a stunning Walla Walla Valley sunset, Mahana Syrah is a complex, lavish expression from The Rocks District of Milton-Freewater.

Named after Mr. Mahana, who established the sister city to Milton in 1889, this Syrah, Viognier co-fermentation is marked by notes of cured meat, olive tapenade and leather.

Aged in large format new oak barrels, a glass of this wine complements the colors of a summer evening spent with friends.
