**BEHIND THE NAME** 

Named after "Doc" McAndrew, who first planted Chardonnay grapes in the Columbia River Gorge, this wine is classic Washington meets Chablis.

Stoney minerality and bright acidity, it is a Chardonnay that could easily fall in line with the finest of Burgundy.

Apple, pear and seaside aromas shine with a dazzle of citrus and the softest touch of oak.

Fantastic with a dozen oysters and works wonders along-side washed-rind cheeses such as Epoisses.
